SHOREHAM HARBOUR RADIO

Mariners are reminded that Shoreham Port operates at a Local Port Services level, as defined in MGN 401(M&F).

The provision of a Local Port Service is designed to improve port safety and coordinate port services within the harbour by the provision of port information to vessels, berths or terminal operators.

Shoreham Harbour Radio operators will provide port related information to the bridge team on request, or when deemed necessary but will not participate in the onboard decision making process. As in any navigation situation, Shipmasters and mariners are expected to exercise good seamanship and comply with The Prevention of Collisions at Sea Regulations (1972) as amended. The authority of the Master is never compromised.

Information provided by Shoreham Harbour Radio, includes;

- Berthing information
- Availability of port services
- Details of shipping movements
- Meteorological data
- Hydrological data
