



## **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

**No. 08 – 2021**

### **DRAUGHT OF VESSELS**

Please be advised that after the recent dredging campaign, the harbour entrance allowance can now be increased.

The draught for all vessels transiting the harbour entrance is now at the predicted height of tide plus **1.2 metres**. This allows for an under-keel clearance of 0.7 metres in calm sea.

Copies of the latest survey are available for viewing at Shoreham Harbour Radio and Harbour Office. Masters of vessels holding Pilotage Exemption Certificates should sight the latest survey at the earliest opportunity.

Masters of all vessels navigating at the entrance of the harbour are advised to proceed with caution and must maintain sufficient under keel clearance having taken into account the draught, speed and characteristics of the vessel.
