- Oversee marine & navigational safety during the commercial tide.
- To attend Shoreham Harbour Radio to set the vessel movement board for the forthcoming tide.
- To deal with any Pilotage and other port matters arising.
- Any other duties as directed

Main duties, tasks and responsibilities as Stand-by Pilot:

- To assist the Duty Pilot to meet the pilotage demands.

Key skills/Person specification

- Class 1 or 2 Master Mariners Certificate, or equivalent.
- Understand and safely demonstrate manoeuvring characteristics of the wide range of visiting vessels.
- Local knowledge of Shoreham Ports Pilotage Area and procedures.
- Knowledge of the Port Marine Safety Code.
- Proactively contribute to the development of departmental policy and procedures.
- Good interpersonal, oral and written communication skills.
- Sound judgement and effective decision making.
- Ability to manage risk and safety in marine operations.
- Ability to lead and act with authority when required.
- Ensuring compliance with all statutory duties as defined in the relevant legislation.
- Teamwork, including bridge teamwork with a wide variety of visiting ships' masters.
